


MARIA ARMINDA DO N. ARRUDA VICE-PRESIDENT

USP and the Federal University of Pará sign agreement for joint research in the Amazon. The formalization of the partnership marks the beginning of a new phase of collaboration between the two universities through their research centers.

USP and the Secretariat of Agriculture and Supply sign protocol to reduce carbon emissions. In addition to the Protocol for Incentivizing Carbon Emission Reduction, a technical-scientific cooperation agreement was also signed between the two institutions.

Applied Research Center for Innovation and Sustainability in Citrus Farming (CPA), ESALQ, FAPESP, and Fundecitrus establish a research center to combat the most critical citrus diseases worldwide, such as citrus variegated chlorosis and Huanglongbing (HLB or 'greening').

USP and the Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation sign agreement to grant PhD scholarships, that will support doctoral research at the three Study Centers established by the USP Rectorate focused on sustainable development.
